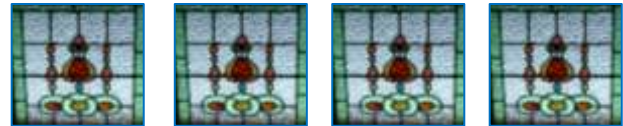
The Manor

Around the site

River walk, pond that can be stocked with trout for fishing, children's play areas and sports hall for 5-a-side football, basketball, badminton, uni-hoc and other indoor games

Local area - Avoca village

There is a footpath from the Manor gates to Avoca village just over 1km away. Avoca is home to Ireland's oldest hand-weaving mill and there are lovely walks above the village



Local Area - Meeting of the Waters

The Meeting of the Waters made famous by Thomas Moore's poem is accessible by foot approximately 5km from the Manor along a footpath



Local Area - Avondale

The birthplace and home of Charles Stewart Parnell is 9km from Ovoca Manor. Set in 500 acres of parkland with a number of marked walks, the House with tea rooms is also open to the public



Local Area - coast

There are dozens of beautiful beaches from 10 minutes drive from the Manor



Local Area - Mountains

The Wicklow Mountains are on the doorstep



Local Area - Glendalough

One of the most visited places in Ireland, the monastic site and spectacular scenery of Glendalough are just 30 minutes from Ovoca Manor
